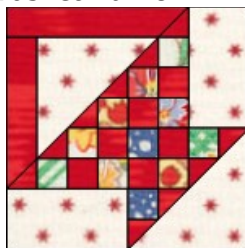




## Basket Full of Minis



16 1/2" block raw\*

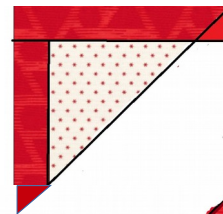
\*Raw means when you have finished the block before it goes in a project

### Cutting Instructions

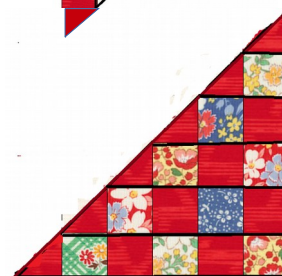
Fabric	1 <sup>st</sup> cut	2 <sup>nd</sup> cut
1 pack of 42- 2 1/2" squares (minis)		You will use 11 per basket.
Basket fabric	6- 2 1/2" squares 5- 2 7/8" squares 1- 14" x 2 1/2" rectangle 1- 12" x 2 1/2" rectangle	Cut once on the diagonal 
Background	1- 8 7/8" square 2- 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles	Cut once on the diagonal 

### Sewing Instructions

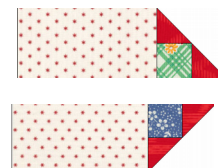
Sew the short and then long basket rectangles to one of the background triangles. Trim even with the bottom of the background triangle.



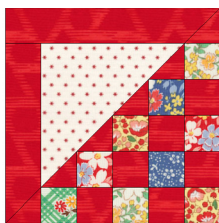
Using the 11 minis and the basket fabrics. Construct the basket. Use the picture below as guide to placement of triangles and squares.



Make the "feet" of the basket. Sew to the background rectangles. Make sure to look how they are sewn as they have to be sewn opposite of each other to fit.



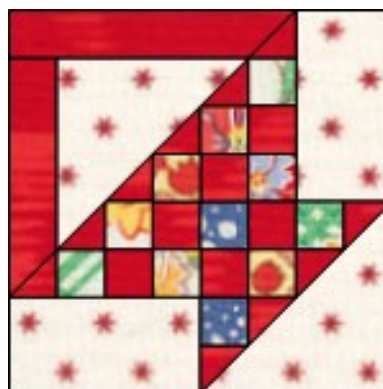
Sew the top to the basket.



Sew the “feet” to the basket.



Sew the remaining background triangle to the bottom of the basket.



For our quilt of 4 baskets:

We used 1 pack of Minis+ 2 more 2 1/2” squares.

1 1/8 yards background

5/8 yard of red solid to make our little table topper.
